The programme is created from the things you most want to hear about, the great work you most want to share and the commitment to keep making it better for each other and those we care for.

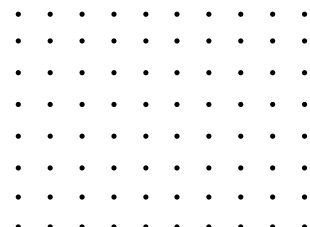
The conference programme is a mix of invited emergency care experts and the best picks from a wide call for papers.

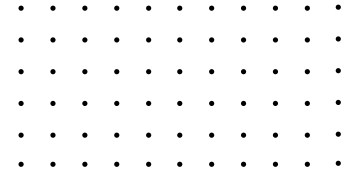
Expect an eclectic mix of speakers and sessions from practical 'how to', to high level strategy, people talking about what's worked for them and cutting edge evidence for improving patient care.
